The research conducted by the Swedish School of Textiles in the field of Fashion Design focuses on practice-based design research in the *Body Dress Space* program, with focus on researching new methods and definitions in fashion design for the development of new functions and expressions in clothing. The full-scale textile labs at the Swedish School of Textiles provide a unique milieu for practiced-based research, to develop, deepen and critically examine the artistic foundation for design as craft and profession with focus on the expressiveness of garments.

The vacant position is part of the University's strategy to strengthen practice-based research in the field of fashion design and it focuses in particular on the development of methodological and design aesthetic foundations of the field.

Research is conducted in close collaboration with national and international research groups. The position will provide excellent opportunities for specialization within a very topical area of research.

Doctoral students are appointed under Chapter 5 of the Higher Education Ordinance. The study period will correspond to a maximum of four years of full-time studies. The initial period of employment lasts one year and is typically renewed one year at a time. Normally, 80 per cent of the time of the position is reserved for research studies and dissertation work within the doctoral programme at the department. The remaining 20 per cent of the time is spent on department duties, which shall consist of teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels in relevant courses, supervision of theses, and participation in external projects and assignments. In this manner, the doctoral studentship is extended to a total of five years.

This position requires the applicant to hold a Master's Degree in Fashion Design or similar qualifications. For admission to a doctoral programme, the applicant's ability to benefit from research education in the field is assessed. It is essential that the applicant has good commands of English, both spoken and written.
